

## REDLAND BRIDGE CLUB INC PROCEDURE FOR ENTRY TO THE CLUBHOUSE

- Bring your own pen, water bottle, hot drink container, \$5 note and completed Health Declaration form.
- Sanitise hands on entry. **Maintain social distancing.**
- Forehead temperature will be taken. Please move your hair if necessary and *do not move* until you are told the procedure is complete. The thermal scanner will be held 5 to 10 centimetres from your forehead.
- Complete your Health Declaration form before you come to the clubhouse and sign and date it when you arrive; your temperature will be recorded on this and held in a Register for 56 days as required by Qld Health. If you have not completed a form, please take a form to one of the distanced chairs along the wall and complete it **USING YOUR OWN PEN**. Return the form to the person at the entry. If you answer **YES** to any question or you have an elevated temperature, you will be required to leave the premises.
- Pay your \$5 note for table fees at the door.
- If you do not have a copy of the full “Conditions of Entry and Bridge Play”, please take a copy from the front desk.
- Proceed to the washroom and wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water in the proper COVID-19 manner. Dry hands with a paper towel.
- Take your seat at one of the specially distanced Bridge tables. Please ***Do Not enter the kitchen*** – this area is restricted at all times unless you are washing your hands.
- Entry to the clubhouse is restricted to members (and Beginners who will be asked to join as soon as possible).
- Please follow the conditions of Bridge Play
- ***Social distancing and respiratory hygiene requirements must be complied with at all times. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in you being required to leave the premises***
